 - WG 4: Strengthening the Danube Region






- "Civil society is dynamic and essential for the preservation of democracy" (Leopoldo Martinez, CDDA)

 - Capacity builder (Providing training and capacity building)
 - Representative (Voice of marginalised and under-represented)
 - Citizenship champion (Encouraging citizens participation)
