About the Project

The current wave of migration has caused a situation in which fears wildly mix with legitimate worries of European citizens; the economical aspects mix with humanitarian conventions; the political interests with moral reasons, and rational arguments with emotions.

In this labyrinth, YCDN wants to start by providing orientation for the participants of its workshops, and guide to distinguish the true from the supposed fears in society,

debating the most common arguments, pro and contra migration.

Aims

We aim at a better understanding of the topics deep complexity and to offer the opportunity to deal with the political discussion in a more sensitive and informed basis.

Method

In the framework of the workshops, discussions in the whole group and small group (3-4 persons) alternate.

The structured discussions, different exercises focusing on partial aspects of the topic, and their self-reflection; enable the
